The 257 entries provide information about the scope and content of the documents, the locations, the titles and popular names of the bills and laws, the publication dates, the author, the LC card number, the OCLC number, the SUDoc number, the CIS number, the UPA citation, and other information about relevant bills. Information is given about the specific sources and types of sources in the Congress, the Congressional Research Service, and the executive agencies. The annotations describe the types of documentation covered in a work, provide notes about citations and the pagination of original documents, and refer to the location of texts in the Statutes at Large.
